# About SAIF

Shanghai Advanced Institute of Finance (SAIF) was established at Shanghai Jiao Tong University in April 2009 by the Shanghai Municipal Government. SAIF's mission is to become a world-class institution of research and advanced learning in finance and management. SAIF is committed to developing top talent and cutting-edge knowledge, focusing on Chinese markets and their global connections. Our world-renowned faculty, with over 70 members, hold Ph.D. degrees from top universities, and over two-thirds were tenured at world-class research universities before joining SAIF.

SAIF earned international accreditation from The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) on February 28, 2016. In 2021, AACSB extended SAIF's accreditation for an additional five years. In 2020, SAIF's MF program was ranked No. 1 in Asia for the third consecutive time by Financial Times.

## **Program Information**

#### **Tentative Academic Calendars:**

Fall Semester: Sep. 2024 – Jan. 2025 Spring Semester: Feb. 2025 – Jun. 2025

The official start of the semester is the registrations of SJTU and SAIF. Students must conduct SJTU and SAIF registrations separately. SAIF doesn't have an exam week. Once students complete the courses (including the assessments) at SAIF, they can return to their home university.

#### Full-time Workload:

1 SAIF credit is equal to 12 contact hours. Exchange students' minimum workload is decided



by their home universities.



#### **Courses at SAIF:**

Exchange students will take courses alongside SAIF students from the Finance MBA and Master of Finance programs. Courses for exchange students at SAIF are usually electives arranged on weekday evenings and weekends. Detailed course information is available upon SAIF course selection. #### Language of Instruction: English

#### Learning Expectations:

Class attendance is mandatory. Missing one-third of a course and above may result in a failing grade.

#### Grading and Transcripts:

Courses are graded as A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C,

C-, D, and F (Failure). Incoming students don't have the make-up exams and course retaking at SAIF. Transcripts of the exchange students will be issued upon students' application.

#### Chinese Language Course:

An optional Chinese language course is available to exchange students for free.

## **Students' Life**

#### Accommodation:

SAIF is located at SJTU Xuhui Campus. Oncampus dorms for international students are limited and will be assigned first-come, first-served. Students should find off-campus accommodation in case they cannot book on-campus dorms. Oncampus dorms for Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan students will be arranged at Minhang Campus with the same conditions as local students.



#### **Student Activities:**

SAIF provides a range of student activities to exchange students, including orientation, lectures with speakers from academia and industry, and cultural activities.

SAIF runs an orientation for all incoming exchange students at the beginning of each semester. It covers school and program introduction and academic policies.

SAIF offers distinguished speaker series lectures hosted by leading figures from academic and industry fields. We invited Prof. Oliver Hart, 2016



Nobel Prize Winner, and Ning Tang, Founder and CEO of CreditEase in the past.

SAIF also organizes Chinese Culture Activities for students when the situation allows, such as Qingming Festival Activities, Dragon Boat Festival Activities, Chinese Calligraphy Learning Events, etc.

#### Facilities:

Exchange students are entitled to use the school and university facilities such as the student cafeteria, the financial trading lab, discussion rooms, etc. A student ID card will be provided to exchange students to grant access to those facilities.

SAIF will set up SAIF Account and Email for exchange students after they are officially admitted. Students should check SAIF email frequently; all important notices will be sent to the SAIF email address.



## **Practical Information**

#### Visa:

An "X2" visa is required for all international exchange students to enter China (except students whose residences are in Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan). SAIF will mail students visa documents and admission notices for their visa applications. Please check with the Chinese Embassy/Consulate in the student's country/area for detailed visa application requirements.

#### Insurance:

Insurance is required of all incoming students. Students must follow the Shanghai Jiao Tong University notices to purchase the required insurance before university registration. The insurance will be checked upon students' arrival by SJTU and SAIF.
