Bergen Student Skerries Cruise 2010 (29th May)



→ Fact: This is your chance to experience the skerries outside of Bergen on the beautiful sailing ship Statsraad Lehmkuhl. This 7 hour trip is an experience not to be missed! The Statsraad Lehmkuhl is a three-masted barque rigged sail training vessel.

It was built in 1914 as a school training ship for the German merchant marine. After the First World War the ship was taken as a prize by the United Kingdom and in 1921 the ship was bought by former cabinet minister Kristoffer Lehmkuhl (hence the name, which means 'Cabinet Minister Lehmkuhl'). With the exception of the Second World War, when she was captured by German

troops and called Westwärts, the ship had belonged to Bergens Skoleskib until it was donated to the Foundation in 1978.
