
Midnight Sun Marathon (25.Juni 2011)

♦ Fact:

In Tromsø, at almost 70° N, the sun doesn't set for 2 months, from the middle of May till July 19. This is one of the main things that make MSM a very special and exotic event. Even in cloudy weather it is broad daylight 24 hours a day. The start time for the Marathon is at 8:30 p.m. and the Halfmarathon at 10.30 p.m.



It was a special marathon contest when every participant was forced to run in a raining day. As you can see, the organizer gave every runner a yellow raincoat, which was really huge and uncomfortable to run with. Despite the coldness (5° C) and awful weather, most of the runners were warming up and trying to go outside to get used to the rain and chill before the contest started. I felt so happy to see everyone so enthusiastic to run even in the midnight! It's the most special half marathon event I have ever taken part in.
