Visas	\$175	\$25	\$25	Tourist visa required to enter Egypt: \$25 USD (all terms) + processing fee for Egyptian residency (fall/spring): equivalent of 7,100 EGP that must be paid in a major foreign currency. For details about visas, click here.
Meals	\$2,150	\$500	\$1,000	AUC does not offer a meal plan but on campus there are several dining outlets and a convenience store. Click here for details on dining. These amounts represent ~ 2 meals/day at inexpensive restaurants and 1 meal/day at a mid-range restaurant for the duration of the term.

Non-AUC Housing	\$2,000	\$500	\$1,000	Standard off-campus (non-AUC affiliated) apartment that students find independently. AUC program housing is only available on the main campus in New Cairo so students in the ALIN program (hosted on the downtown campus) generally choose this option.
