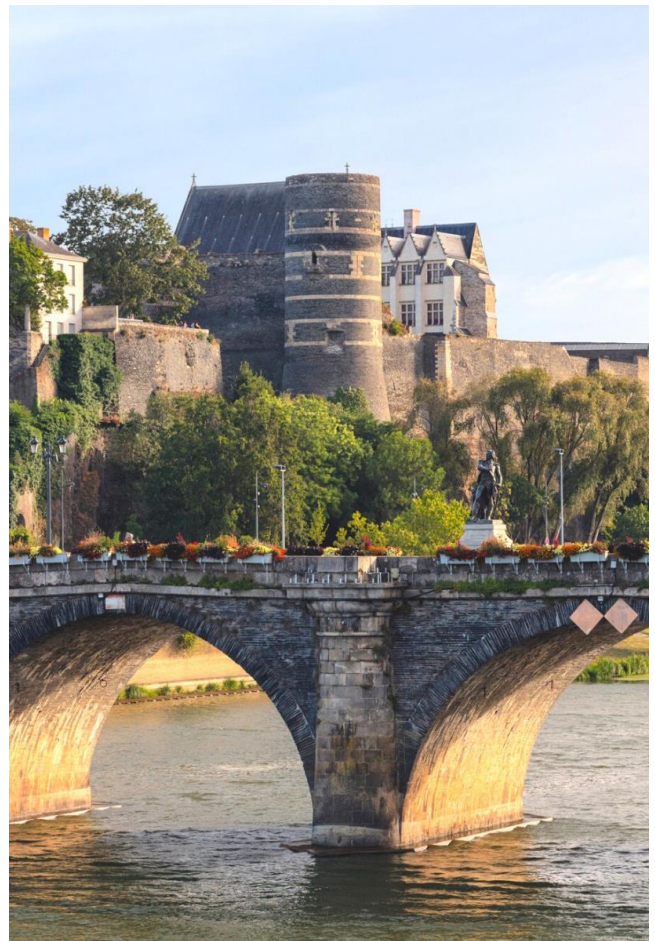

Language Requirement: For the programmes taught in English, we strongly recommend that non-native English speakers or students not taking their home university degree in English provide a *TOEFL* score of 550 or [equivalent](#) or have an English professor complete the [English language certificate](#), attesting to a minimum of B2 according to the Common European Framework.

For the programmes taught in French, we strongly recommend a B2 French level.
