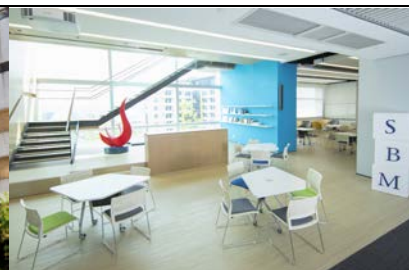


Estimated Living Expenses

Estimated Break-Down of Costs per Semester for reference (in HKD):
