Students select by themselves their preferred courses in Kozminski Virtual University (selection needs to be approved by student's home university). Access to the platform will be given 2 weeks before the semester starts. Undergraduate and graduate students may choose courses from Bachelor and/or Master programs (selection needs to be approved by student's home university). Law students may choose courses from Business studies as well from both levels. Polish course for beginners is available but not mandatory.
