

## ABOUT US

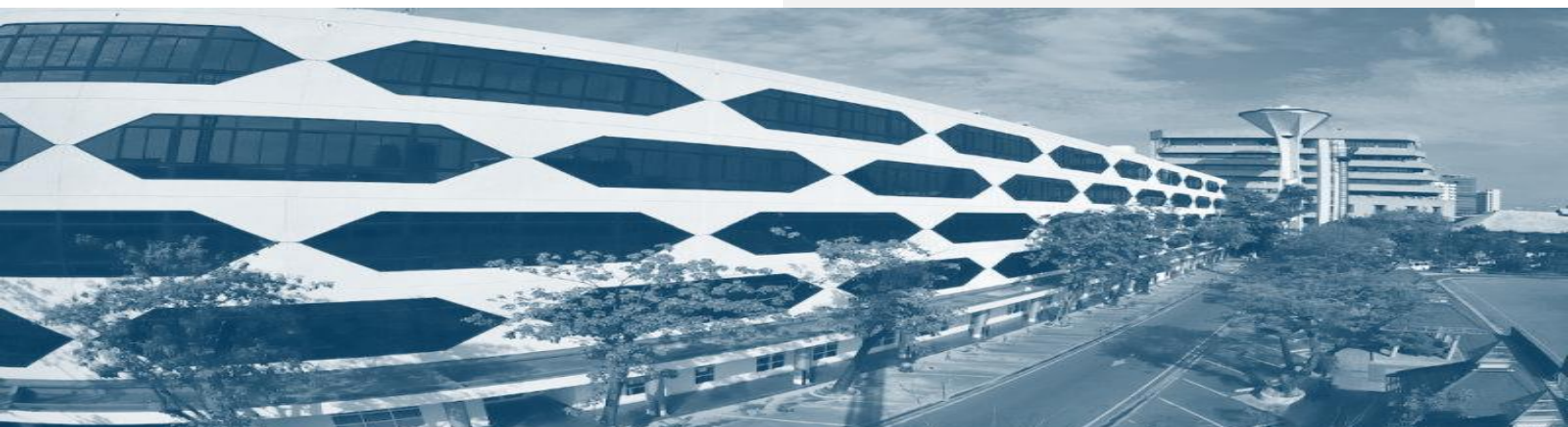

<b>Application</b>	Coordinators are asked to nominate students by completing the e-form and submitting it to the CIA by the specified deadline. Once the nomination period has ended, the CIA will send the online application form directly to the students, typically within one week after the conclusion of the nomination period.

**Learning Expectations:** Students are expected to attend all lectures and seminars, complete all course-related assignments, and take examinations as scheduled to receive a course grade. Additionally, students must adhere to the rules and regulations of their respective international programs.

**NOTE:**

1. Students must take examinations at the assigned time. If a student is unable to do so, no make-up examination will be provided.
2. Early departure is not permitted.
3. Students are required to remain at the school for an additional week after the final examination period concludes.
4. Students participating in the exchange program at Thammasat Business School (TBS) are expected to be in good physical and mental health to ensure a positive and fulfilling experience.

A digital PDF document will be transmitted via email to the International Office of partner universities approximately two months subsequent to the completion of the final examination period.

**Estimated Expenses:**

- Housing: USD170 - 700 per month\*
