We offer both undergraduate and graduate programmes, fully in English or fully in French. Students have access to all our campuses depending on their level of studies. We offer the possibility of changing campuses between semesters if students stay for a full-year (except for double degree programmes).

- ✓ **Full-time workload per semester:**

Full-time workload is 30 ECTS credits per semester for regular students, we do not require a minimum of ECTS for exchange students.

- ✓ **French as a foreign language:**

English-taught programmes offer the opportunity to take one course of French as a foreign language (non-credit bearing).

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Language of instruction depends on the programme and can be French or English.

We accept language certificates from the home university.

Native students in French or English are waived of this requirement.

For students participating in the programmes taught in English:

UNDERGRADUATE:

B2, TOEFL IBT 72, IELTS 5.0, TOEIC 750

GRADUATE:

B2, TOEFL IBT 83, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC 790

For students participating in the programmes taught in French:

UNDERGRADUATE & GRADUATE/

B2 on DELF and TCF scores

ACCOMMODATION

EM Normandie has a partnership with an online housing platform, [Studapart](#), where you can find offers from property owners, student residences, agencies or the school community. You can connect to Studapart once you have your EM Normandie login. The HUB (students office) will also contact students studying in Le Havre & Caen about reservations for the CROUS student residences. They are government-owned and usually low-cost. - ✓ **Oxford campus :** ≈ 1000£ per month

AIRPORT PICK-UP

HEALTH INSURANCE

FRANCE

Students have two options : subscribe to a private health insurance or register with the French national health insurance upon arrival. It is free of charge for all students.

UK

Students must subscribe to a private health insurance in their home country or apply to NHS (free for UK nationals, EU students and students with a visa valid for more than 6 months).

IRELAND

Students must subscribe to a private health insurance in their home country.
